## WELCOME TO ALL SAINTS


Whether you are a visitor or are joining us online or coming home to All Saints, we welcome you this morning.

We encourage you to take part fully in the service, and invite all baptized Christians, regardless of denomination, to receive Holy Communion.


May you know God's presence and His peace in this place.

## **The First Reading**

The souls of the righteous are in the hand of God, and no torment will ever touch them. 

All baptized persons are welcome and encouraged to receive Holy Communion. Communion will be distributed at the foot of the chancel steps.


